

Materials

yarn

worsted weight kitchen cotton, such as Lily Sugar 'n Cream or Lion Cotton (1 ball makes 2

needles U.S. size 7 straight

notions darning needle

1. Garter-framed Stockinette Cloth

Cast on 37 stitches (or number for desired width)

Row 1-6: Knit

Row 7 and all odd rows: Knit 3, purl to last 3 stitches, knit 3

Row 8 and all even rows: Knit across

About 1 inch before desired length, knit last 6 rows.

Bind off loosely and weave in ends.



2. Moss Stitch Cloth

Cast on 37 stitches (or number for desired width)

Row 1: Knit 1, purl 1 to last stitch, knit 1

Row 2: Purl 1, knit 1 to last stitch, purl 1

Row 3: Repeat Row 2

Row 4: Repeat Row 1

Repeat rows 1-4 until piece is square. Bind off loosely after row 2 or 4; weave in ends.

3. Stockinette Striped Cloth

Cast on 37 stitches (or number for desired width)

Row 1: Knit

Row 2: Purl

Row 3-4: Knit

Row 5: Purl

Row 6: Knit

Row 7: Purl

Row 8: Knit

Repeat rows 1-8 until piece is square. Bind off loosely after row 3 or 8; weave in ends.

4. Basket Weave Cloth

Cast on 37 stitches (or multiple of 8 stitches +5 for desired width)

with Row 1 or 5.

Bind off loosely and weave in ends.

Repeat rows 1-8 for desired length, ending

Row 1: knit across

Row 2: k5, *p3, k5, * repeat from

to to end

Row 3: p5, *k3, p5*

Row 4: repeat for 2

Row 5: knit across

Row 6: k1, p3, *k5, p3,* k1

Row 7: p1, k3, *p5, k3,* p1

Row 8: repeat row 6
